

# Theatre Scholarship Application

## ELIGIBILITY

The Department of Theatre, Film, and Media Arts awards two renewable scholarships to prospective incoming students each year. In order to be eligible for scholarships awarded through this application process in the area of Theatre, the student must be an incoming Theatre Major in the department with a high school GPA of 3.5 or above. The scholarship may be renewed annually for a total of four years of funding, as long as the student maintains their status as a Theatre Major and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above.
