## **Requirements for Screenwriting Minor**

Minor programs are not required for graduation.

Required for Screenwriting Minor: 18 Credit hours required from departmentally approved course list.

- A student may not take a major and a minor in the same subject.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or any additional minor(s).
- Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.
- Transfer and EM credit hours: a student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.
- X193 individual studies credits: No more than 3 credit hours accepted toward minor

Pre-requisites: Some of the advanced courses included in the minor have prerequisites; check with your advisor for further information.

Grades required: Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor; Minimum 2.00 cumulative point-hour ratio required for the minor.

- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count toward the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of coursework graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor.

Approval required: The minor course work must be approved by the program's Academic Advisor.

No Film Studies minor course can be repeated without pre-approval from the Film Studies Program office.

The minor program form must be filed before graduation application is submitted.

Once a minor program form is on file in the college office, any changes must be approved by departmental (minor) advisor.

Students are strongly encouraged to declare the minor and file minor program form as early as possible.

Declaration of minor and filing of minor form must occur at least one term prior to graduation term.
